Guidelines for Reimbursement

These guidelines are intended to provide guidance at our Bi Monthly meeting.

1) How do we know how many scholarships are available?

Nassau General Service Group offers 3 scholarships maximum within the amount budgeted, even though there may be more than 3 who desire to attend . We reimburse registration fee, 2 hotel nights, meals , transportation. We need receipts within 30 days & at the next Reps meeting to give a 3 minute report.

*** NGSF asks if you have already gone to a Event on a scholarship , please defer.

However, if we do not have 3 scholarships requests for that Event , then we will offer the scholarship.

2) How do our members know what Events are coming up?

Nassau General Service DCMC when giving their DCMC report , notifies the members at the Bi Monthly meeting prior to the Event. Members that are interested in attending check they have the dates available. Requests can then be submitted to the DCMC @ dcmc@aanassaugs-ny.org

3) How to offer financial assistance , when a County Member wants to go

but finances prohibit their participation. We want our members participation to be inclusive. For those who are unable to finance costs to warrant participation. Nassau General Service Group can give a \$150 petty cash check upfront. The \$150 is to help cover registration, meals , transportation. NGSF will pay registration fee & register the 2 hotel nights. The member financed will need a personal credit card for check in at the hotel for the 2 nights.
